Reminders

Trailers, Vehicles and Campers Off Village Streets

Winter is coming and that means snow and snow clearing. The Village has asked all residents to have extra vehicles, campers, and trailers off Village streets as of October 15. Village equipment cannot safely manoeuvre around parked trailers, campers, or vehicles. **The Village is NOT responsible for damages or snow -locked vehicles.**

Remember that shoveling or blowing snow onto Village streets is not allowed. Snow from your driveway is to be stored on your property

Pets

Pet License renewals are Due January ! The Village of Vibank requires all cats and dogs to be licensed. Licenses are available at the Village Office for \$5.00/ animal/ year. Licensed pets make it easier to find lost owners, or to notify searching owners of their pet's demise. Failure to license your pet could result in a fine.

Bylaw Enforcement

Village of Vibank has appointed Vision Quest Advisors as the contracted bylaw enforcement officers for the Village; they have copies of the Bylaws and will be in the Village addressing infractions. They are impartial and will be assessing all properties in the Village. Notices/orders to remedy will be sent out to homeowners if necessary.

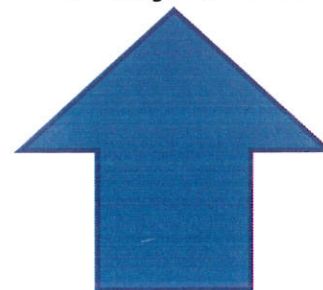
Village Office Closed December 24-January 1

Village taxes are due prior to December 31. Last day to pay taxes in person, over the phone, or on-line is December 21st. 15% penalty is added to your unpaid taxes as of January 1st.

All Village debts including UTILITY, Water & Sewer bills, unpaid orders to remedy, and bylaw fines WILL be transferred to property taxes and will have a 15% penalty added on January 1, 2019
