### Atv's and Dirt Bikes

Unlicensed vehicles are not allowed to cruise on Village Streets, alleys, and sports grounds. All safety equipment should be worn when driving, and do not let children drive without supervision. Stay off the Sports Ground and all green space in the Village, these vehicles are not to be driven around town.

### Break and Enters

The Village has had a few attempted break and enters around the Village and items stolen from unlocked vehicle. Be aware. There are many helpful tips on line at SGI Canada. Here are a few:

Securing your premises

- Keep your shrubbery cut back so it doesn't block windows and doors.
- Illuminate as much of your property as possible.
- Exterior doors should be solid, not hollow. Metal doors provide the best protection against forced entry.
- Use a fencing style that won't conceal a burglar's activities. Remember, if you can't see out, others can't see in.



### Bylaw Enforcement

Village of Vibank has appointed Vision Quest Advisors as the contracted bylaw enforcement officers for the Village; they have copies of the Bylaws and will be in the Village addressing infractions. They are impartial and will be assessing all properties in the Village. Notices/orders to remedy will be sent out to homeowners if necessary.

## LANDFILL – GREEN FILL SITE

**OPEN FOR THE SEASON** -Hours of operation are 11:00am to 2:00pm every Saturday weather permitting. Closed over long weekends and Holidays

Please remember that only natural materials are permitted at the site. Grass clippings, garden refuse, tree branches and natural wood products (no nails or paint) etc. are allowed. Any plastic bags must be emptied and removed from the site.

### **Pets**

Off leash dogs are a concern in the Village, please Leash, Scoop, and License your pet. All dogs are to be leashed when out for a walk, do not let your dog out to play, if your yard is not fenced, use a tether. Dogs and cats wander it is in their nature, and as a responsible pet owner, you want to ensure your pets safety. Remember your scooper bag when out for a walk, and do not use the sports field as a puppy toilet, kids are at play. Pet License renewals are Due January 1<sup>st</sup> for the calendar year. The Village of Vibank requires all cats and dogs to be licensed. Licenses are available at the Village Office for \$5.00/ animal/ year. Licensed pets make it easier to find lost owners, or to notify searching owners of their pet's demise. Failure to license your pet could result in a fine.
