A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW 2015-09 TRAFFIC BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE TO REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON THE USE OF THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE VILLAGE OF VIBANK AND PERSERVING ORDER THEREIN

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Vibank in the Province of Saskatchewan in accordance with The Municipalities Act, wishes to enact an amendment to Bylaw 2015-09 to regulate the speed of motor vehicles on a public highway and to regulate the parking of recreation vehicles and trailers within the Village of Vibank.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Vibank, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Purpose and Intent

This bylaw amendment is intended to:

- i) Regulate the speed of motor vehicles within the Village of Vibank and;
- ii) Identify areas where reduced speed is limited and;
- iii) regulate the parking of Recreational Vehicles and trailers on public highways from November 1 to March 31 inclusive within the Village of Vibank.

tt) "recreational vehicle" means a self-propelled or towed vehicular type unit, primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping or travel use and which is used solely as a family or personal conveyance and in no way used for commercial purpose. Without limiting the foregoing, recreational vehicles include: (i) Travel trailer; (ii) Cabin trailer; (iii) Tent trailer; (iv) Truck camper; (v) Motor home; (vi) Park trailer; (vii) Fifth-wheel travel trailer;

uu) "trailer" means a non-motorized vehicle which is generally pulled by a motorized vehicle and features an open-top rear cargo area (bed) and is used for the hauling.

Add to Part 11 Infractions 6 Infractions e) Parking 16. Recreational Vehicle and Trailer

16. No person shall park a recreational vehicle or trailer on any highway within the Village of Vibank from November 1 to March 31 inclusive.

Replace: 6 f) Speed 1. No person shall operate a vehicle in the municipality at a speed greater than forty (40) km/hr

With:

6 f) Speed

1. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in the municipality at a greater speed than which is posted on any highway.


2. All highways within the Village of Vibank shall not exceed 30km/hr with the exception of those highways which are identified in Appendix 6 - Schedule A –for which will have a maximum speed of 25km/hr and forming part of this Bylaw.

This bylaw amendment shall come into force and effect on November 1, 2019.


