VILLAGE OF VIBANK BYLAW NO. 95-7

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW ON TO VILLAGE STREETS.

The Council for the Village of Vibank in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That residents in the Village shall not blow or shovel snow onto Village streets or use their own equipment e.g tractors, trucks or bobcats to move snow on public streets without the consent of Council.

Residents who fail to comply with this bylaw may be fined under the general penalty bylaw for the Village.

This bylaw shall come into force effective Nov. 30, 1995.
