


BYLAW NO. 96-5

VILLAGE OF VIBANK

A BYLAW TO PERMIT AND REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF VIBANK IN THE PROVINCE OF SASK.,
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. "HIGHWAY" MEANS A HIGHWAY AS DEFINED IN THE VEHICLES ACT.
2. UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE SNOWMOBILE ACT, IT SHALL BE LAW-
FUL TO OPERATE A SNOWMOBILE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9 A.M. AND
9 P.M. ON ANY HIGHWAY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPALITY.
3. THAT SNOWMOBILE DRIVERS OBEY THE LAWS WITHIN THE VILLAGE
REGARDING SPEED LIMITS AND TRAFFIC SIGNS.
4. THAT SNOWMOBILE DRIVERS ONLY USE THE PUBLIC STREETS AS A
METHOD OF THE QUICKEST POSSIBLE ROUTE OF LEAVING THE VILLAGE
STREETS.
5. THIS BYLAW RESTRICTS THE SNOWMOBILE DRIVERS OF USING THE
STREETS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY AS A MEANS OF DRIVING FOR
PLEASURE, (e.g. racing)

6. THE USE OF SNOWMOBILES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OTHER THAN THE
RIDERS OWN PROPERTY SHALL BE ~~RESTRICTED~~
PROHIBITED
7. THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT UPON THE
DATE APPROVED BY COUNCIL.
