BYLAW NO. 96-5

VILLAGE OF VIBANK

A BYLAW TO PERMIT AND REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF VIBANK IN THE PROVINCE OF SASK., ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1."HIGHWAY" MEANS A HIGHWAY AS DEFINED IN THE VEHICLES ACT.
- 2. UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE SNOWMOBILE ACT, IT SHALL BE LAW-FUL TO OPERATE A SNOWMOBILE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9 A.M. AND 9 P.M. ON ANY HIGHWAY WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPALITY.
- 3. THAT SNOWMOBILE DRIVERS OBEY THE LAWS WITHIN THE VILLAGE REGARDING SPEED LIMITS AND TRAFFIC SIGNS.
- 4. THAT SNOWMOBILE DRIVERS ONLY USE THE PUBLIC STREETS AS A METHOD OF THE QUICKEST POSSIBLE ROUTE OF LEAVING THE VILLAGE STREETS.
- 5. THIS BYLAW RESTRICTS THE SNOWMOBILE DRIVERS OF USING THE STREETS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY AS A MEANS OF DRIVING FOR PLEASURE, (e.g. racing)
- 6. THE USE OF SNOWMOBILES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OTHER THAN THE RIDERS OWN PROPERTY SHALL BE RESTRICTED.
- 7. THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT UPON THE DATE APPROVED BY COUNCIL.
