The Village would like you remind everyone in your subdivision on what NOT to flush. You may have heard that the Village experienced a lift station incident earlier this month. This incident was localized to your subdivision.

Putting the wrong things down the drain can damage the sewer system, cause sewer backups in your home, and can have serious/expensive environmental consequences. All Vibank residents should be responsible for what they flush or pour down drains.

Basically, the only thing you should ever flush down a toilet is human waste (urine and feces) and toilet paper. Here is a list of some of things to keep out of the toilet:

- disposable diapers
- tampons and sanitary pads
- mop heads
- cotton balls and swabs
- mini or maxi pads
- unused medications
- condoms
- cleaning wipes of any kind including swiffer pads, and flushable pads
- facial tissue
- bandages and bandage wrappings
- plastic bags
