There is NO off leash area in Vibank, this means all pets must be leashed when out of your yard!

## REMEMBER ....

Off leash dogs and roaming cats are not permitted in the Village, please Leash, Scoop, and License your pet. All dogs are to be leashed when out for a walk, do not let your dog out to play, if your yard is not fenced, use a tether. Dogs and cats wander it is in their nature, and as a responsible pet owner, you want to ensure your pets safety. Remember your scooper bag when out for a walk, and do not use the sports field as a puppy toilet, kids are at play. Pet License renewals are Due January 1st for the calendar year. The Village of Vibank requires all cats and dogs to be licensed. Licenses are available at the Village Office for \$5.00/ animal/year. Licensed pets make it easier to find lost owners, or to notify searching owners of their pet's demise. Failure to license your pet could result in a fine.

Your pets need you to be responsible.



#### Atv's and Dirt Bikes

Unlicensed vehicles are not allowed to cruise on Village Streets, alleys, and sports grounds. All safety equipment should be worn when driving, and do not let children drive without supervision. Stay off the Sports Ground and all green space in the Village, these vehicles are not to be driven around town. Bylaw 2020-002 is available on our website at Vibank.ca the prohibited areas map Appendix A marked in yellow show the areas of the Village off limits to ATVs and dirt bikes, as are all Village streets, back alleys, and laneways. You are to drive your atv's the guickest route out of the Village and enjoy them outside of Village limits.
