Village Governance

The Village Administrator's Office is located in the beautiful Heritage Building at 101 – 2nd Ave. The Office is responsible for assuring the efficient and effective management of day to day Village operations, and through the Administrator, implementing the policies and bylaws of the Village.

The Village Office is open Monday to Friday from 8Am to 4 Pm, closed over the noon hour.

The Village taxes are levied yearly and are due on December 31st. An early discount opportunity is available until July 31. The Village mill rate is determined by Council following the passing of the upcoming year's Budget. The Village of Vibank uses reverse osmosis system for the Village water service

Payment of taxes, utilities, licenses etc. can be paid in one of the following ways; Cash; Debit; Visa, Master Card, Cheque - made payable to "Village of Vibank"

Village Water:

In 2012 the Village installed a Reverse Osmosis water plant, distributing the highest quality of water to residents of the Village. Reverse Osmosis water gives residents the highest safety quality of potable water, with the added benefits of non-corrosion taps and no need for a water softener.

Water and sewer billing is done every two months.

Village Wastewater:

In 2018, the Village together with both the Provincial and Federal government completed upgrades to our waste water lift station. Upgrades included new pumps, new building and electrical. The Village has two lift stations that feed a waste water lagoon just south of the railway tracks outside of Vibank.

Village Garbage & Recycling:

The Village uses Loraas Disposal for curbside bin garbage and recycling pick up. A calendar and recycling information is available on our website at www.vibank.ca.

The Village also runs a green landfill site from spring to fall (open and close dates are weather dependent). Trees, leaves, and garden waste, plus any wood products unpainted and without nails or screws are allowed at the Land fill.
